Students will draw or model simple 2D shapes. Students will identify 2D shapes in the environment using the names of shapes. Use shapes to build a picture


Background: We see shapes all around us.


- Students learn to work with 2D and 3D figures in kindergarten




- Shapes can be everywhere.
