## Practice #1:

Read this short paragraph and answer question.

David helped his dad build a patio. They poured concrete for the floor. The ceiling was made from aluminum. Instead of walls, they hung criss-crossed strips of wood called lattice. The sun shines through the open spaces.

Think back to the video.

- The **character** is the people or animals in the story
- The **characters** work together.

Question: Who are the characters in the story?

## Practice #2:

Read this short paragraph and answer question.

David helped his dad build a patio. They poured concrete for the floor. The ceiling was made from aluminum. Instead of walls, they hung criss-crossed strips of wood called lattice. The sun shines through the open spaces.

Question: Where does the story take place?

Think back to the video.

- The **setting** is where the story takes place
- The setting is also **when** the story takes place.

Read the short paragraph again and answer questions on paper. When writing remember to use complete sentences.

Question: What was poured to make the floor?

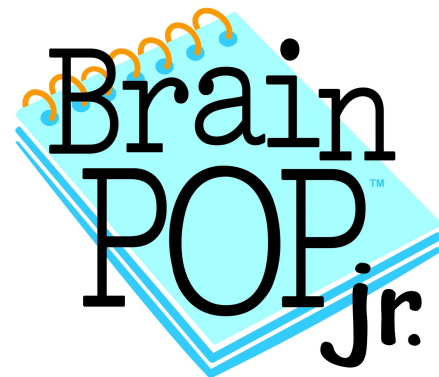
Question: What metal was used for the ceiling?
