# Background: Students use sounds, sight words, and pictures to write about a topic.


- Students will use pictures to draw about a topic

Write the Words


Trace the CVC word that matches each picture.


Stretch out the words and write the sounds you hear:





















### Practice #3: Mix and Fix Sentence

#### All About Writing


This type of writing is teaching.

Think about a jackrabbit's habitat, what things do you think a jackrabbit eats to survive?





Trace the four sentences about what jackrabbits eat. Click the picture to print.


