Warm Up: Play this classic game with Kermit the Frog.






Which one is **not** blue?




This balloon is **not** blue. It is yellow.



Which one is **not** round?




A book is **not** round. It is a rectangle.



Which one is **not** a pencil?




This is **not** a pencil. It is a pen.

Which one is **not** a tool?










A bike is **not** a tool. It is a toy.



Which one is **not** a flower?












A bird nest is **not** a flower. It is a home for birds.










A toothbrush is **not** a toy. It is for cleaning your teeth.



Which one is **not** an animal?




A chair is **not** an animal. It is furniture.












The stove is **not** cold. It is hot.




Which one is **not** clothes?
