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Dates

Summer Success takes place four days a week, Monday-Thursday, for elementary and middle school students. Summer Success is planned for *June 2—June 26th.* If that date is pushed back due to the number of snow days this winter, you will be notified by phone.

High school students enrolling in summer school should check with their high school for locations, times and dates.

A Friday Fun Day option is available, for a fee, for students enrolled in *Summer Success* (see more information above).

Friday Fun Day

You can enroll your K-5th grade student in Kids' Safari or your 6-8th grade student in Latitude for Fridays only during *Summer Success* for a fee.

Those programs also offer before and after school services.

Transportation is not provided for Friday Fun Day or before and after school services.

Nutritionally Speaking

Breakfast and lunch will be served each day for *Summer Success* at no additional cost.

Additional beverages may be purchased for 45 cents each.

ISD students will be able to make a la carte purchases using their student meal accounts.

No negative account balances are allowed during *Summer Success*.

Pre-K Possibilities

Children 6 weeks to Pre-K can enroll in Early Education programs at Sunshine Center and Hanthorn; children Pre-K (3, 4, 5) can enroll at each of the elementary summer schools.

At the conclusion of *Summer Success* these programs will be combined to fewer locations.

Transportation is not available for this program.

Early Education is a yearround program with costs associated; payment help may be available from DSS and other income eligible programs.

To enroll in this program contact your home school and ask for the Early Education Specialist or contact our Early Education office for tuition questions at 521-5599 ext 10008.



Enrollment and Gift Cards

Enrollment for *Summer Success* is online. Simply go to www.isdschools.org after February 24th and click on the **Summer School** tab to enroll. Those without computer access will be able to sign up in their child's school. Be sure to have your student's ID number ready when enrolling.

Students from any school, private or public, may attend the Independence School District's *Summer Success* program at no cost.

Registration opens on February 24th. Those who are signed up by April 11th will be eligible to receive a gift card at the end of the program based on their child's attendance.

0 days missed = \$50 gift card

1 day missed = \$25 gift card

Students who miss more than one day will not be eligible for a gift card.

All students must be pre-enrolled. No walk-ins on the first day.

Getting There

Transportation for K-8th grade *Summer Success* will be provided for those students who qualify and register for transportation services by May 16th. You can register as part of the online Summer Success enrollment process by going to **www.isdschools.org** and clicking on the **Summer School** tab. Those without computer access will be able to enroll in *Summer Success* at their school site.

Bus routes and stops may vary from the regular school year. Stops are set to provide a central gathering location, typically at intersections. Parents are encouraged to escort their child to and from the bus stop.

Bus passes will be mailed after the May 16th deadline. For questions about bus transportation please go to the **Summer School** tab on the district website or call 521-5335.

June 26 -	Last Day of Summer Success
