Grab some
markers,
crayons, or

Other colors to include are pinks and teals.




Also grab a blank piece of paper if you have one. Ruled paper is fine as well.




Fold your paper in half either way. Open it back up and draw along that fold.

Write cool on the left side and warm on the right.



Using a ruler or something with a straight edge, you are going to make lines that will create shapes. These type of shapes are called geometric because they have only straight edges, corners, and points.




Next you will color the warm side with reds, PRACTICE oranges, yellows, and pinks. Then do the cool side with blues, purples, greens, and teal.
