
Art Explorations Lesson: april 23, 2020

Objective/Learning Target: We will be drawing our southwest patterns.


Reminder of what we will be making.

Here is what you'll need for today:


- Your paper with a cow skull drawn on it
- Pencil
- Eraser
- Ruler or something with a straight edge



On your paper make horizontal lines. Make sure to skip those areas where the skull is drawn. I made mine by using the width of the ruler. I continued to make a line and move the ruler down to make another. I lined the top of the ruler with the line l just drew.




Should look something like this. You will then choose a design for each section that you drew. You can repeat patterns if you'd like.



Southwest Designs


 Yesterday we looked at different designs from the southwest region. You can copy those that are on this slide and the next or create your own.







