For our last week of virtual learning I thought I'd show you art ideas that you can do anytime. Especially this summer!

Painted Rocks

Have you heard of kindness rocks? Maybe you've seen some on my desk. Kindness rocks are rocks that are painted and often have kind words on them. Some are directly given to a person and others are placed around town for others to find. They can either keep or put it in another place for someone else to find!





What you'll need:

- Smooth rocks with a flat side.
- Acrylic paint
- Paint brushes
- Or paint pens
- Sharpie
- Sealer if you have it



This type of rock is the best. But if you have something similar, feel free to use that.

If you like the color of the rock you can start painting it. Otherwise you can paint the background first. Make sure to let that coat of paint dry before you continue.




The ideas are endless! Stripes, polka dots, solid colors, etc.

Once you have the rock painted to your liking, next you will paint your word onto it. This is where paint pens or Sharpies work best. If you don't have those, then paint the word carefully.

Once you've created your rock you'll need to seal it. Ask your parents if they have any. It's usually in a spray can. If not, it will be okay, the paint may start to wear off over time. Have fun!
