


## Art Explorations








Look at these alphabet photography examples. Notice all the different objects that make up the letters 'N' and 'E'.





## Look at these alphabet photography pieces and how they have created words.










Please google alphabet photography to look at other examples and perhaps get some ideas for you project that we will start tomorrow.
