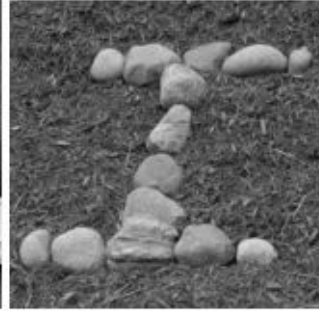
Art Explorations

- A drop down shows select 'no recolor'
- Select any color(s)
