LESSON: April 21, 2020

Objective/Learning Target: We will be looking closer at O'Keeffe's enlarged flowers.

Why did Georgia O'Keeffe paint big flowers?

- She was quoted in saying “I’ll paint it big so they will be surprised into taking time to look at it. I will make even busy New Yorkers take time to see what I see of flowers.”



Let's take a closer look at *Red Poppy*

- Notice the different values in the red poppy.
- Dark near the center then fades to lighter hue.
- Notice the texture of the center of the poppy.
- Notice the petals seems to be smooth.





Let's look at *Jimson Weed*

- Smooth texture on the petals.
- Darker hue towards the center
- The leaves also have different hues and you can assume texture of the leaves.

Tomorrow we will start our version of an enlarged flower.
