POP ART IS A DISTINCTIVE GENRE OF ART THAT FIRST "POPPED" UP IN POST-WAR BRITAIN AND AMERICA. PRIMARILY CHARACTERIZED BY AN INTEREST IN POPULAR CULTURE AND IMAGINATIVE INTERPRETATIONS OF COMMERCIAL PRODUCTS, THE MOVEMENT SHOWED A NEW AND ACCESSIBLE APPROACH TO ART. RANGING FROM QUIRKY TO CRITICAL, THE PIECES PRODUCED BY POP ARTISTS IN THE 1950S AND 1960S COMMENTED ON CONTEMPORANEOUS LIFE AND EVENTS.
