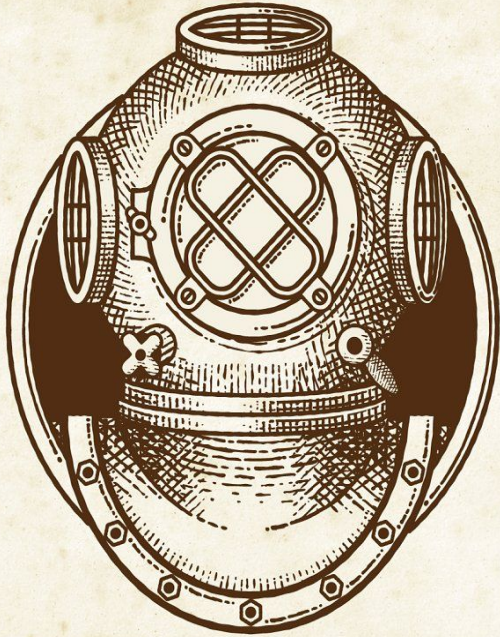
Let's take a look at these prints by Designer Jeremy Childs. He creates these vintage looking prints. What gives it a vintage look?



Recognize the style of shading?

The cross-hatched look gives it the appearance of an old print.

Also notice the items; the top hat, pipe, and tea cup.. All 'vintage' or older items.



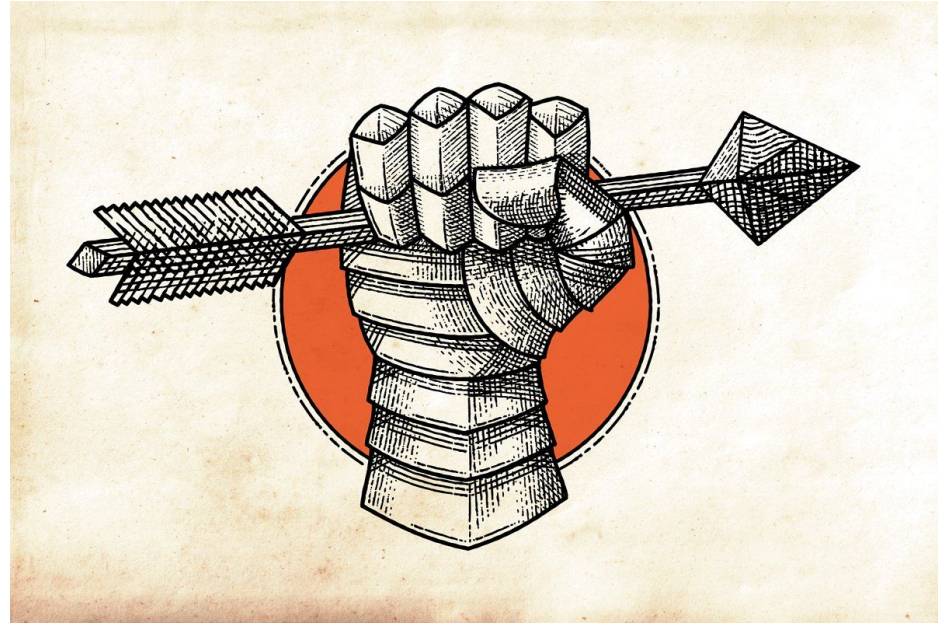

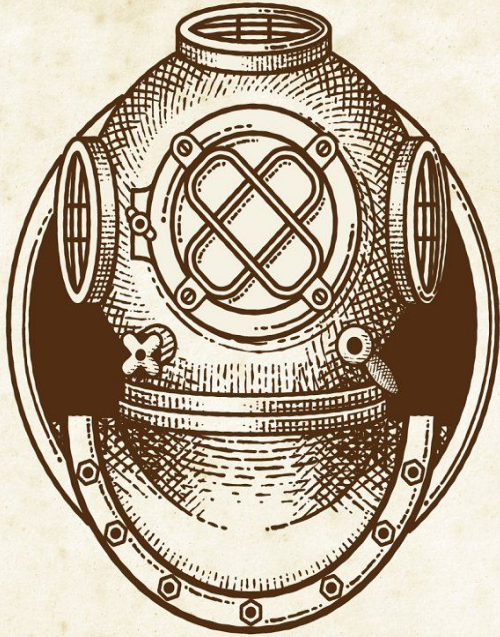
Here is another print by Childs, an old diver's helmet. The color of the print, stained background, and the hatching technique makes this look much older than an artwork created today.

Cross-hatched lines get farther apart and lighter where the value is lighter.

When we add more lines that are closer our value is darker

Contours- when you curve your lines you bring form to your image rather than it being all flat/straight lines
