

Parody

An imitation of the style of a particular writer, artist, or genre with deliberate exaggeration for comic effect.

The trick with creating a parody is to not take too much away from the original masterpiece. When making a parody, you want your viewers to know what inspired it.

Many famous artworks have been parodied. Often it is for comic effect, sometimes we create them to communicate a feeling,, and other times it is done to honor the original but make it relevant to the viewers.









Get out your thumbnail sketches from yesterday. Decide which one you want to use to create into a final materspiece parody. Remember to include a few key Da Vinci techniques and ideas so your Modern Mona is still herself.
