- Learning Target: I can use thumbnails to practice Drawing from different point of view

SKETCHING

Thumbnail sketches are small, loosely drawn sketches of the subject or design in little boxes. :) Just like with the trees, start with your simple shapes.



USING YOUR SPACE

When you fill the little thumbnail square, think of how to use your space.

- *Fill the frame

- *Draw to the edges it does not have to fit neatly

Select a plant in your home or yard.. (I chose a weed) and try drawing it in as many different ways as you can create. (How many ways can you see the plant? Sit on the other side of it.. Zoom in, zoom out, detail of leaf, the pot, etc.)
