

3 colors equally spaced on the color wheel. (colors make a triangle with 3 colors in between each one)




*YELLOW-ORANGE, RED-VIOLET, BLUE-GREEN

There are 2 more options for triadic colors - can you name them?












You will now need the symmetrical line design.

- You are welcome to use the media of your choice: Colored pencil Marker
- Poster paint
- Watercolor
- Fingerpaint
- Nail polish (please use in a well ventilated area though)
- Anything that makes color is fair game - this is a good time to experiment!



YOU CAN USE THE SAME MEDIA AS YOUR COMPLEMENTARY COLOR OR TRY SOMETHING NEW

Pick 1 of the 3 sections to color using the 3 colors of a TRIADIC color scheme.

I'll use blue and red and yellow since my marker color is blue. Be sure all the shapes in that section have either blue or orange when you are done. Leave the other 2 sections white for now.



*You can use tints (lighter) and shades (darker) versions of the color but be sure it's the same color.


**Change pressure or use layering for colored pencils or add white/black to the color if you are painting
