- Learning Target: How do artists see and describe analyze artwork?

Using "artist eyes" should help you with the next step of criticism - Analysis.

To analyze a work of art you are going to pay close attention to the elements the artist used and how they used them .

# These are some basic questions to use when analyzing:

**Analysis:** How is the work organized?

How does the artist use the elements of design in the work of art?

For example: How are colors used?

What effect do they have on the artwork?

What role does texture play in the work?

How has the artist used light?

You can also talk about how these elements are used:

Line

Shape

Space

Form
