- Learning Target: What is the purpose of contrast in art?

How do artist create and use contrast in their works?

What role does contrast play in optical — illusions?

You will need 2 pieces of the same sized paper.

The example in the video is 9x12, but as long as the papers are the same you can use whatever sized paper you want.

Start by folding 1 paper in  $\frac{1}{2}$  "hamburger" (put the short sides together).

Carefully cut the folded paper along the folded line.

What contrast will you use for your drawings?

The artist in the video uses straight and curved lines/shapes as her contrast.

I chose to use lines and forms (3D shapes) in my examples.

Some contrasts that might work for your agamograph drawings are:

Straight lines & curved lines

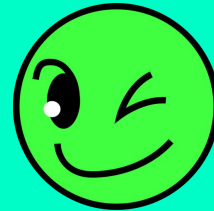
Geometric & organic shapes

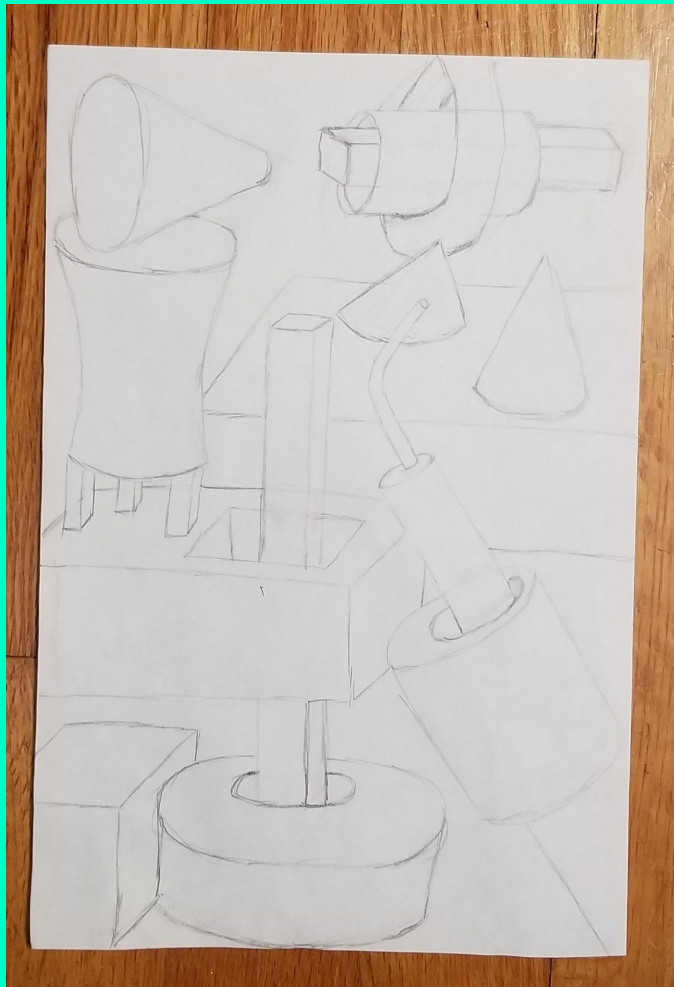
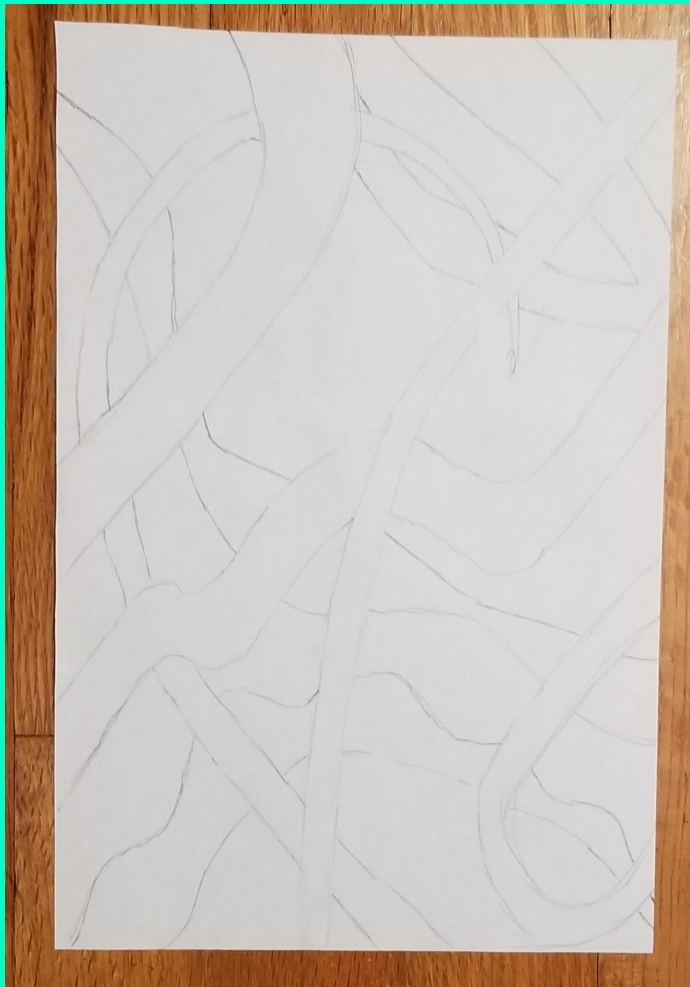
Landscape & portrait
