Today we'll finish the second design for our agamograph. Check out this video for the instructions for a 2 image agamograph

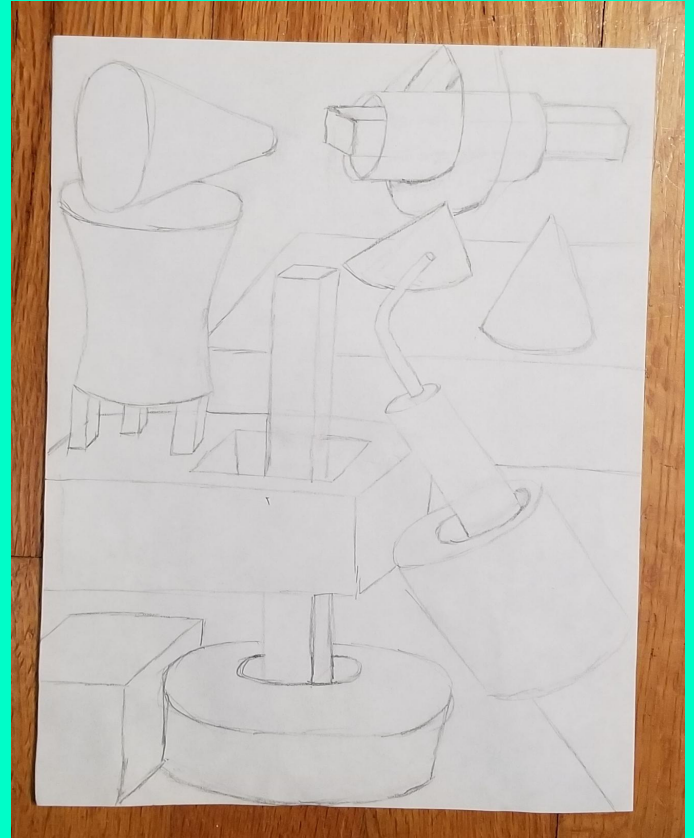

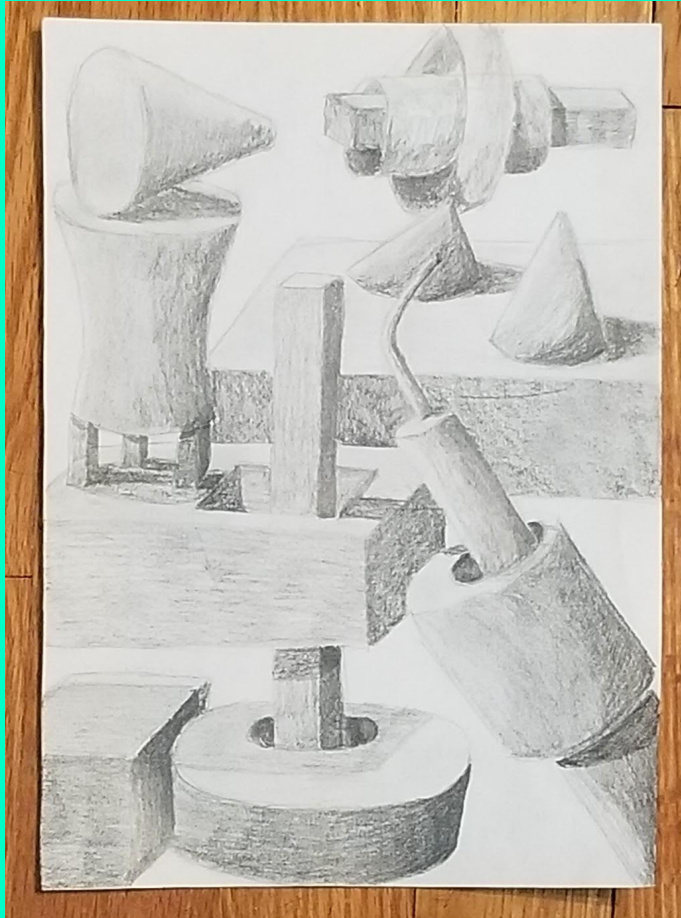
You will need the second pencil drawn design you made this week.



The artist in the video uses washable markers on both her works.

I will use **markers** on the **line design** and **pencil shading** on the **forms** (3D shapes) in my examples to create even more contrast.

For today's work I'll use a pencil to create shading (value) on the forms I drew.



Since I'm going to contrast *color* with *values* in my pieces I'll leave both backgrounds white to create some **unity** (something that ties objects together - like uniforms on teams) in my final agamograph.
