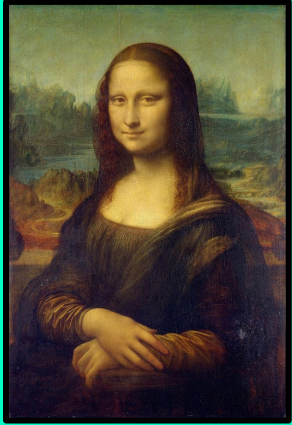

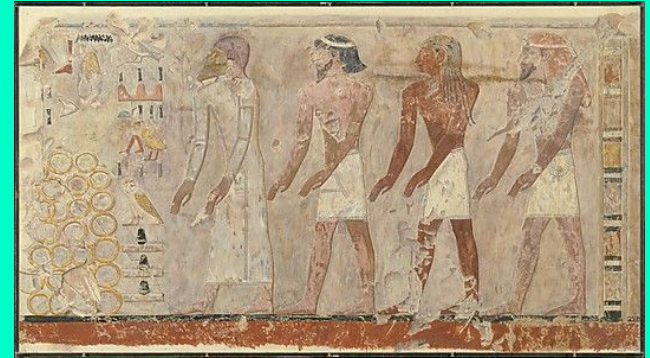
It is helpful to have the same images for these exercises so you can truly compare what the material (media) does instead of comparing the images themselves.
