## Here are some examples of cities created with different media:
















Check your notes from this week - what theme are you using for your city?

Today you will sketch out the city on your paper if you are drawing/painting OR You will create a plan sketch for your buildings if you are sculpting.


#### If you are drawing/painting:







Start with the forms that go with your theme



Then lightly outline details to the buildings - be sure the details go with your theme as well. <u>If you are sculpting</u>: Today you are planning with thumbnail sketches of your buildings to give an idea of how your buildings will look.

Thumbnail sketches are quick, abbreviated drawings. Usually they are done very rapidly and show basic details.
