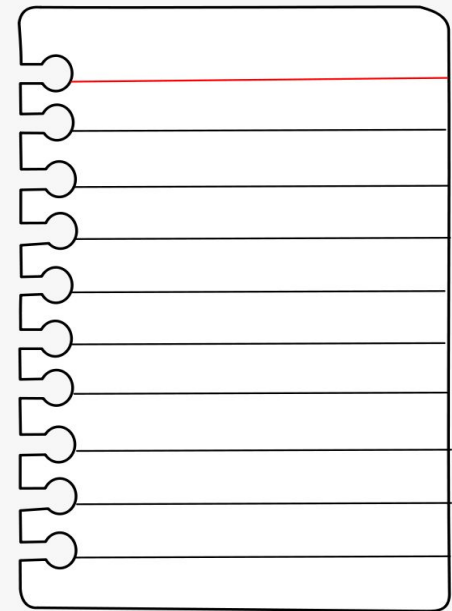
Would you rather do it on Paper than online?
