

The Purpose of Lighting On The Stage

- 1. Visibility: So the audience can see.
- 2. Mood: To establish the emotion of the play
- **3. Support the Story:** Time of day, setting etc.
- **4. Focus:** Lets the audience know what is the most important thing to look at.




Types of Lighting

- 1. **Motivational**—The light appears to actually come from a specific light source such as a window, lamp, candle or a chandelier.
- 2. **Non-motivational**—The light just is, for artistic purposes.
