One-Pager Checklist

- Use unlined white paper.
- Title the One-Pager appropriately to reflect the content.
- Use colored pens, pencils, or markers. The more visually appealing the presentation is, the better.
- Fill the entire page!
- Be purposeful about the arrangement of your One-Pager. For example, have a reason for using a certain color or for placing an object in a certain place.
- Use *at least 3 visual images* to create a central focus for your page.
- Include information about *at least 5 out of 7 of our research focuses*

 - Nature of the Work
 - Working Conditions
 - Workplace Culture
 - Salary and Benefits
 - Job Outlook
- Write a **reflection** about what you find most appealing about the job and what type of person would enjoy it. Explain whether or not you would enjoy this career
