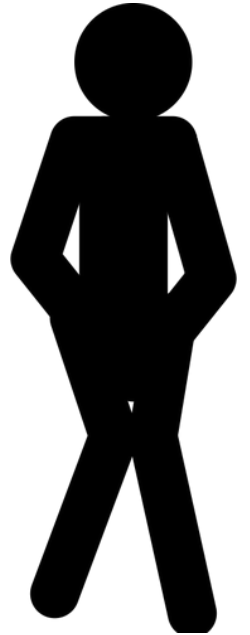

A conjugated verb has a subject, the person doing the action of the verb.
An infinitive doesn't have a subject, it means "to (do something)"
