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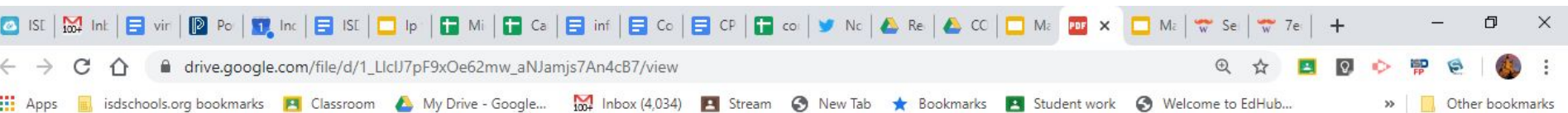

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Here are the forms of the verb poder. Poder= to be able to; can



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Open with

Let's make sure that we know how to conjugate the verb PODER in the present tense:

yo	nosotros/as
puedo	podemos
tú	vosotros/as
puedes	podéis
él, ella, usted	ellos, ellas, ustedes
puede	pueden

Notice the **o-ue** change in some of the forms

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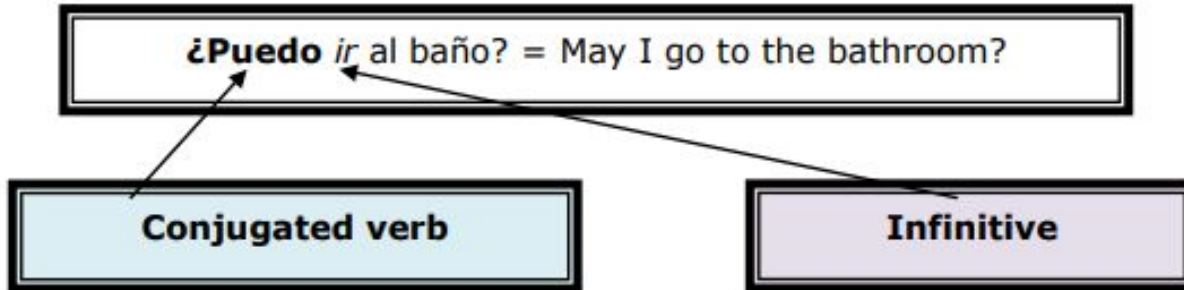

The verb poder + infinitive (to be able to/can do something)



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Justin dice: «¿Puedo ir **al baño?**»
May I go to the bathroom?



Al baño: a + el= al (to the)

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Justin no puede esperar.



Justin cannot wait.
