

You will need a piece of paper and a writing utensil for this activity.



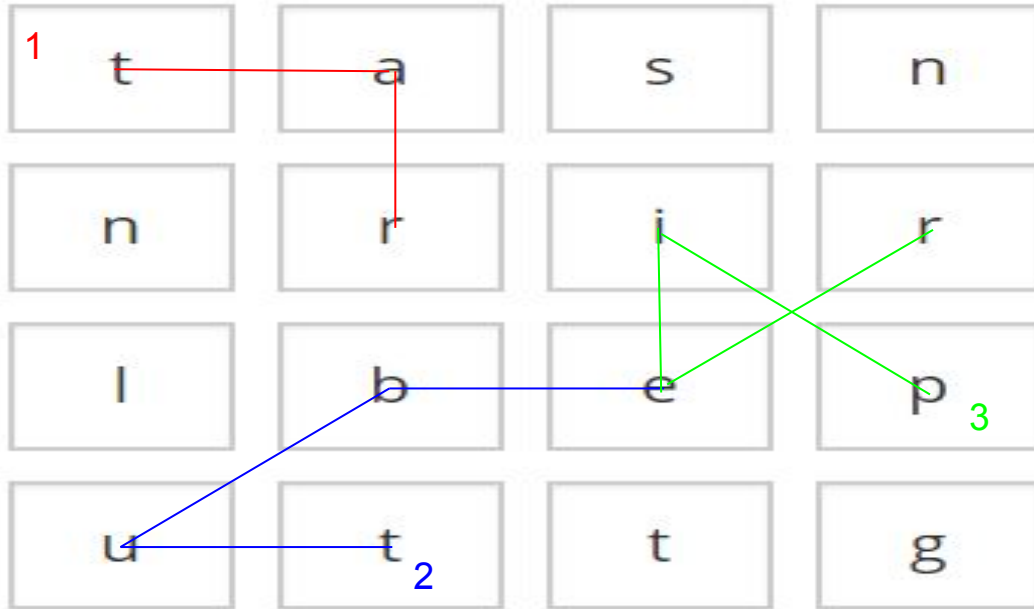
According to [Mindsports Academy](#), word games increase learning by helping us stretch our critical thinking, improve our spelling and increase our vocabulary.

# Practice Word Puzzle



1. Tar
2. Tube
3. Pier

The following point distributions are used for scoring: three letter words and four letter words = 1 point; 5 letter words = 2 points; 6 letter words = 3 points; 7 letter words = 5 points; 8+ letter words = 11 points.

After the three minutes are up, each participant counts how many points they earned from the words formed



# Game Rules

- The letters in the words must be connected in the same order in the grid.
- The letters can be connected by an edge or a corner.
- The word doesn't have to appear in a straight line. It can be tangled around.
- Each letter in the word must uniquely appear in the grid. For example, if the word is ERASE, the letter E must appear twice in the grid. The word can't just loop back and re-use the same E.
- Words must be at least 3 letters long
- Words cannot be a proper noun, such as a name or place.

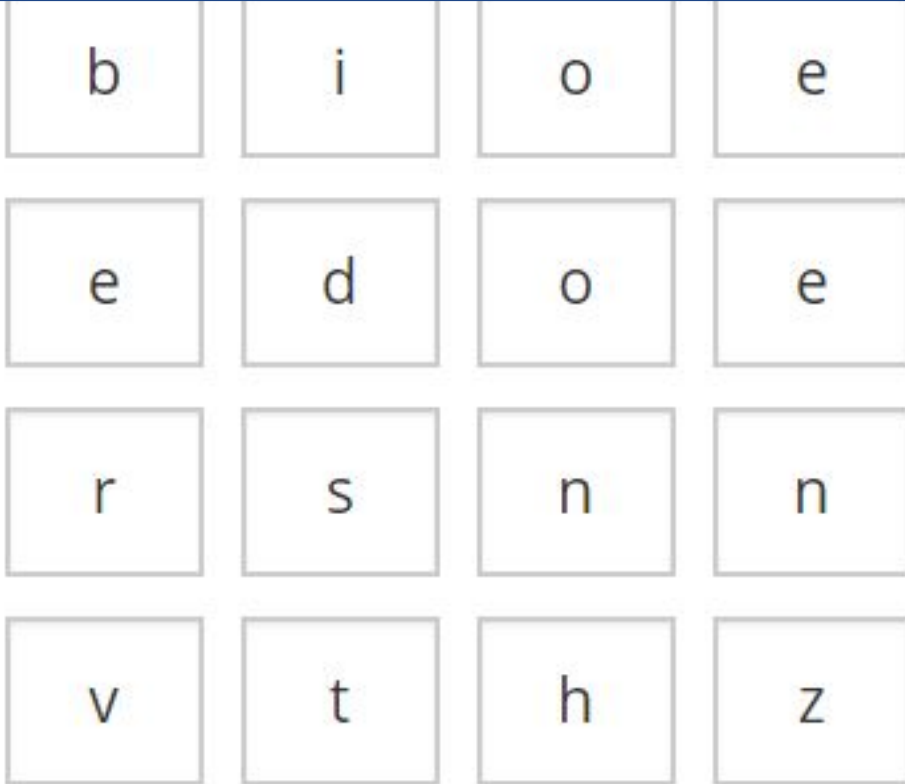
