Let's get started...

- 1. Familiarize yourself with how to access the academies information on the ISD website. Follow these steps.
 - a. Go to https://www.isdschools.org/
 - b. Click on the "Parents and Students" tab
 - c. Click on the "Academies of the ISD" link

From there you will be able to click on whichever academy you are interested in.

Again today we are going to be focusing on the Industrial Technology Academy, so click on the "Industrial Technology Academy" icon.
