Keep and consider your answers for the 2 questions you answered as a guide or template for next Monday when we set SMART goals.

For example if I answered the question about my grades with "Most of my grades first semester were As and Bs then second semester after cross country I had a couple of Cs too."

I could consider converting this in to a goal by rewriting it as "I will maintain grades of As and Bs outside of cross country season".

This goal can easily be made into a SMART goal!
