
Yesterday we met John Williams, possibly one of the most famous movie composers in the history of movies.

What is foley?

Focus on Foley:

Decide who will make each sound!

Figure out how you will make your sound(s)! What objects, voices, body percussion, or instruments could you use?





Practice adding your sound(s) to the film. Watch closely so you can add your sound at the correct time!





Time to record! Make sure you don't miss your sound, and try not to make any other noises during recording!

If you can't record, that's ok, just try and perform for someone in your household!

Don't forget to mute the original video....so it's just your awesomeness!
