




Several weeks ago we discussed the rule of the dot.


What is the rule of the dot?



Rule of dot: The dot adds $\frac{1}{2}$ of the original value to the note.

So: Half note gets two counts. Half of two is one. 2 + 1 = 3





Quarter note: Quarter note = 1 count Half of 1 is $\frac{1}{2}$ 1 + $\frac{1}{2}$ = 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ Dotted quarter note = 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ counts

Eighth note: Eighth note = $\frac{1}{2}$ count Half of $\frac{1}{2}$ is $\frac{1}{4}$ $\frac{1}{2} + \frac{1}{4} = \frac{3}{4}$ Dotted quarter note = $\frac{3}{4}$ count

Can you figure out what a dotted sixteenth note would receive?
