The music in a film is known as the film score. Each piece of music within the score is known as a cue.



Film music can be divided into two categories:

1. music contained within the action, and

2. background music.


The FOUR main functions of music in film is to:

JAWS The Importance of John Williams


Here is a scene from Jaws, first without music, and then with the music that John Williams composed for the scene!
