# Instructions

In yesterday's lesson you were introduced to the Arts in KC project. For a reminder go back to the April 29th guitar lesson and review the procedure.

Yesterday you chose a famous musician that is important to Kansas City and begin your presentation with information on them. Today you will be researching some arts organizations in KC.

As you are researching them look for important information to add to your presentation. Where is it located? Where is it located? What type of art or performances do they present? How is it funded? Are there any upcoming performances? What purpose does it serve?



## Instructions (cont'd)

Your presentation should include 8 slides. That would include 1 title page, 2 slides on each of the topics (a famous musician, an arts organization, and a famous Kansas Citian), and one resources or works cited slide).
