**Students will learn to use Songmaker from Google Music Lab to remix a premade song.**



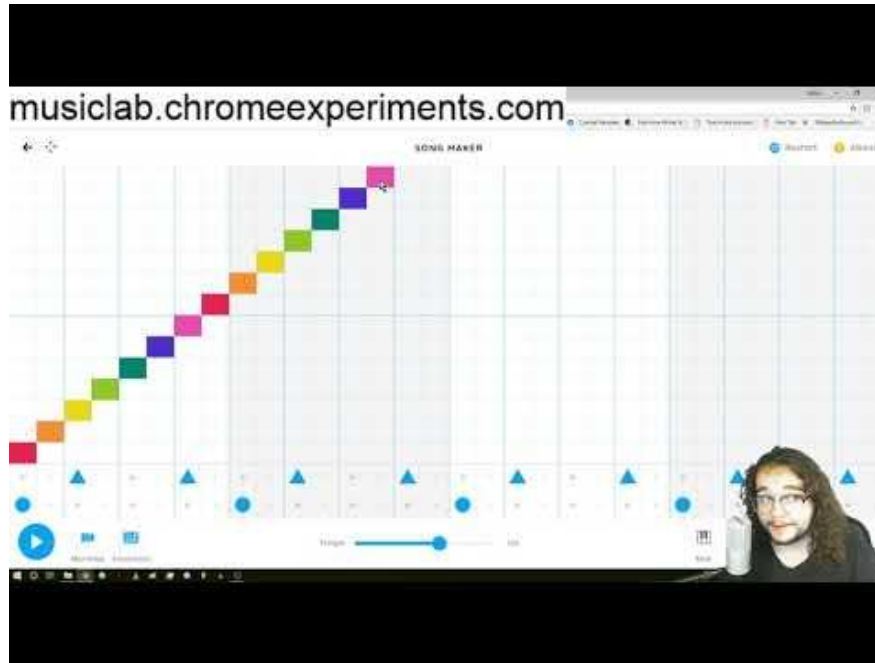
# Warm-Up Activity
