Practice Pointers

Before we begin, here are some important points to remember when dribbling a soccer ball.

- Relax body (upper body over the ball)
- Keep eyes on the ball.
- Dribble ball softly.
- Keep ball close to the body.
- Good balance with knees slightly bent.
- Control ball.

Practice Pointers Cont.

- Focus and concentrate on using your laces.
- Point your toe down and touch the ball with the laces.
- Dribble with your laces.
- Never dribble with your toe.

If don't have small cones, use small objects such as, extra shoes, small sticks you can place in the ground or any small object your parents will allow you to use.
