Review

- Digestion is the process your body uses to break down food into simple substances that the body can use.
- Digestion begins in the mouth.
- The esophagus is the tube that transports food down into the stomach.
- Gastric juices start the breakdown of proteins in the food pieces.
- Material that is not absorbed in the small intestine passes into the large intestine.
- The pancreas produces insulin, which moves sugar into the cells.
- The liver is the digestive organ that is responsible for breaking down and absorbing fats.
