# Lesson Introduction/Background Information:


This week we will be going on a Multi-View Tour of the World. Each day we will virtually visit a famous landmark, learn background information, and finally draw it's front, top, and side view.

#### **Practice:**


- 1. The bridge connects which two cities in California?

Now it's time to take what we learned last week about multi-view drawings and use those skills to draw this bridge like an engineer would.


What would this bridge look like from the top, front and right side?
