Something Green

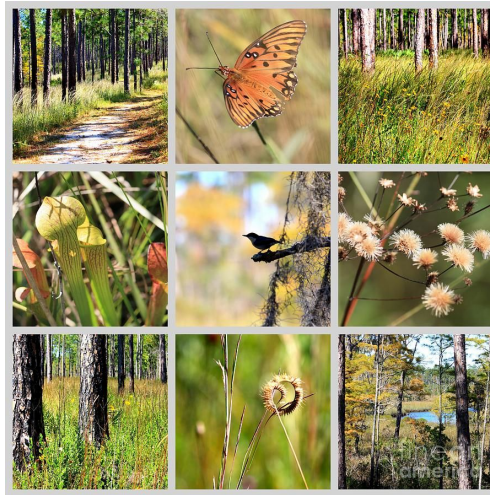
Rainbow

Try to find all of them

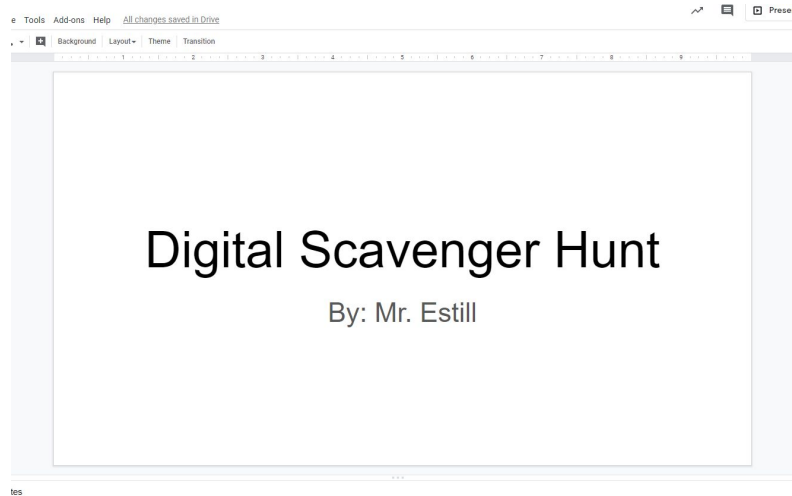


Practice:
