

6th Grade Intro to Gateway Lesson: April 29 (Part 3 of 5)

Objective/Learning Target:
Students will draw objects in isometric view.



Warm-Ups:

Look around the room you are in. See it through an isometric view "lens." Find 5 objects you would be able to draw as a isometric sketch.

What shaped objects do you feel most comfortable drawing?

Watch Video: <u>Drawing a Tissue Box in Isometric View</u>


What you will need:

Writing utensil


Ruler (optional)


Five household items to draw (think books, boxes, etc.)




Practice:

Draw each of your 5 objects in isometric view. As you draw make sure to keep similar sides equal length and parallel.

What shapes were more challenging to draw? Why?
