6th Grade Intro to Tech Lesson: April 7 - Lesson 2

Learning Target:

Students use digital Google tools to create a map of their world while also practicing writing and geography skills.

Practice:

For today, you are going to add your first layer and start adding places to your MyMap. Follow the steps below, or go to the next slide for a video going through the steps. 1. Go to https://www.google.com/maps/d/.

- 2. Click on the map that you created as part of Day 1's activity to open it.
- 3. As you could perhaps tell from my example, MyMaps are organized by layers. Layers should have a theme, like "My Daily Life", "Where I Want To Visit", "Schools I've Attended", or more - use your imagination!
 - 4. To name your first layer, click where it says "Untitled Layer" and name it after what your first layer's theme will be.
- 5. Now to add your first location! You can do this two ways search for a city, landmark, or address in the MyMaps search bar, or zoom in and manually drop a pin on the location.
 - 6. Add several locations to your first layer, and customize them by adding descriptions, changing the icon, and adding pictures.
