Today's Tip:


If you are struggling with the construction of parts, sometimes it is helpful to break apart the shapes individually to put them together like a puzzle. Don't be afraid to play, move, rotate and recolor parts. You never know what you will end up with. To help you understand this see the Animated GIF below that shows just the head portion of my selfie South Park Styled Character

Each of the parts sometimes look silly or not right when they are by themselves on a page, but when you allow yourself to move them around, color them, rotate and so on, they can come together to make a cool character, whether they are traced or free-drawn with the tools!
