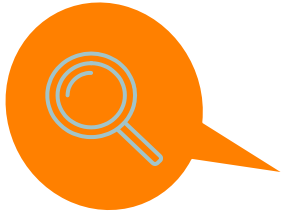

Pull all three Adobe Spark Formats together by:

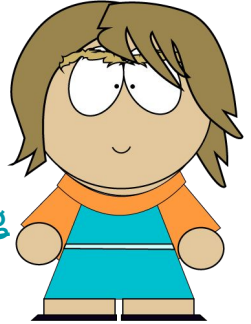
1. Creating a Spark web page that says something about you or something you are passionate about or good at or something you just want others to experience in a positive way.
