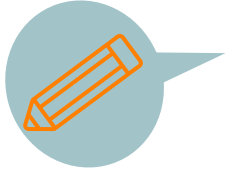

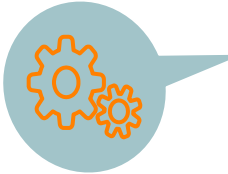

Step 2: Putting the pieces in Adobe Spark & Recording Any Audio

Open [Adobe Spark](#)

Begin putting in your images, video pieces & Text. Remember you can also search for images right in Adobe Spark if you still need to.

Some things to remember:

- Keep it short - under a minute to no more than 2 minutes
- Your key message should be in the first 30 seconds. Don't keep people wondering too much.
- Speak in 2nd person if narrating or writing text, using words like "You" and "Your."
- Use simple language - don't confuse the viewers.
- Keep a casual, conversational tone if narrating

Do not be afraid to make changes even though you had a plan. If something isn't working change it!

Practice:

STEP 3. Add Music only when the entire Explainer Video is done. If you are not done, you may research for music but do not put it the rest is finished.

Because there are limited choices in Adobe Spark in terms of Music. A good free place for music is the [YouTube Audio Library](#). Here you can search music by Genre, Mood, Instrument, Duration & Attribution. Be careful not to get too specific when doing a search. General single words like soft, mysterious, happy, drums work well.

Also Make sure to check the Attribution: when checking this menu choose “*attribution not required*”
If attribution is required, a piece of music will look like below and you will need to copy and paste this information on your credits slide.
