The following are the basic steps to apply for a scholarship.

- 1. Plan ahead.** Most scholarships are reviewed in the spring for the following semester. If all MCC scholarships are not fully awarded or more funds become available later in the school year, MCC will reopen the review process for those funds still available. All scholarships are awarded based upon available funds.
- 2. Read requirements thoroughly.** Read the scholarship and grant requirements carefully and refer to the contact information to find out where to obtain the right application. Meeting all the requirements of a scholarship does not automatically qualify you to receive a scholarship. A committee at each college awards the scholarships, unless otherwise noted. You must have a minimum 2.0 G.P.A. to be considered for any scholarships, unless a higher G.P.A. is noted.
- 3. Fill out an application.** Fill out the MCC scholarship application and attach all the required information and documents. Applications with missing information will not be reviewed and you will miss your

opportunity to qualify for a scholarship or grant. You can apply for more than one scholarship. You may apply for up to six scholarships with one MCC application. Some require different applications. Metropolitan Community College Board of Trustee policy limits students from receiving more than one institutional fee-paying scholarship per year. If the scholarship requires that you submit financial aid forms, you must complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid. These forms are available from your high school counselor, your campus financial aid office or online at www.fafsa.ed.gov. When completing the form, use MCC's school code 002484 to speed processing.

- 4. Ask questions.** If you have questions, contact the financial aid office at the college you plan to attend. Office hours vary from campus to campus, so please call ahead.

Residency: Resident of Clay or Platte County.

Other: Must submit a written recommendation from an instructor, a college counselor or a high school counselor. For scholarship renewal, a 2.0 G.P.A. must be maintained.

Area of Study: Must be pursuing a career in engineering and indicate intent in writing to attend UMKC to pursue a bachelor's degree in engineering.

Academic Performance: A minimum G.P.A. of 2.75 in math and science ACT scores of 20 or better.

Enrollment Status: Full-time.

Financial Need: No requirements on financial need. (Preference given to Pell Grant eligible students.)

Other: Student submits an application plus a written recommendation from a math or science instructor. To remain eligible for renewal of the scholarship, the student must be a full-time student throughout each semester. If the student drops below a G.P.A. of 3.0 or below full-time status, the committee has the right to review the student's progress for reconsideration of the scholarship for the next year.

Amount: Two awards each year for books, tuition and fees up to \$750 a semester.

Academic Performance: Must have at least a 3.0 cumulative G.P.A.

Enrollment Status: Full-time.

Financial Need: Must demonstrate financial need as shown on the Student Aid Report.

Other: Recommendation from instructor required. Awarded for two semesters immediately preceding graduation. Must have achieved a minimum of 24 credit hours in liberal arts at MCC. Agreement by student to attend a four-year institution after MCC graduation and to pursue a bachelor's degree in liberal arts.

Amount: Based upon available funds.

R.A. LONG FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP

Residency: No restrictions.

Area of Study: Technical or health career tracts.

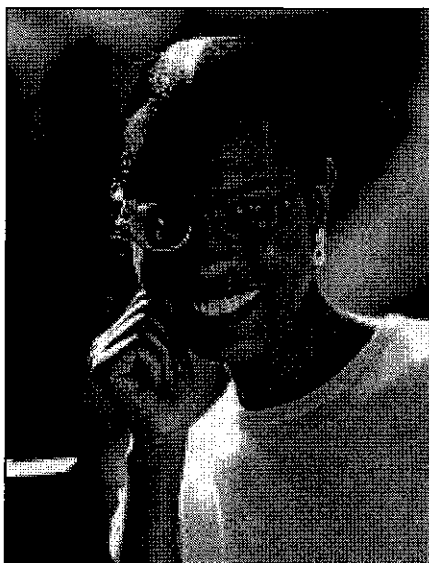
Academic Performance: Must have at least a cumulative 2.0 G.P.A.

Enrollment Status: Full-time or part-time (minimum of six credit hours).

Financial Need: Must demonstrate financial need as shown on the Student Aid Report.

Other: First preference is for DeLaSalle graduates or other GED students, with a preference for graduating seniors. Must be an American citizen or have resident status. Renewable with no limit on number of semesters if 2.0 GPA is retained.

Amount: One-half tuition costs, plus books, tools and supplies. (Second half is matched by MCC Foundation.)

Residency: In-state (covers in-district costs only).

Area of Study: Any area.

Academic Performance: Must have at least a cumulative 2.5 G.P.A.

Other: Must reapply each semester for renewal.

Amount: Based upon funds available.

HAROLD A. MANKER SCHOLARSHIP

Residency: In-state resident.

Area of Study: All, but must be taking a course(s) leading to a degree or certificate.

Academic Performance: Must have a 3.0 G.P.A. Must meet the 3.0 G.P.A. requirement for renewal.

Enrollment Status: Full-time or part-time (minimum of six credit hours).

Financial Need: No requirement.

Other: Must be a direct descendant of a former U.S. Postal Service railway mail service worker or if no student can be identified with these credentials, then the applicant must be a U.S. Postal Service worker or dependent. Also, a letter from a non-

family member verifying applicant's lineage (relationship) and a form of identification verifying that the holder of the letter as the student applying for the scholarship.

Financial Need: No requirements.

Other: Must reapply each semester for renewal.

Amount: \$250.

Residency: No requirements.

Area of Study: English or journalism.

Academic Performance: Minimum 3.0 G.P.A. in English or journalism and an overall 2.5 cumulative G.P.A.

Enrollment Status: No requirements.

Financial Need: Must demonstrate financial need as shown on the Student Aid Report.

Other: Must submit written recommendations from an English or journalism instructor or college counselor.

Amount: Based on available funds.

MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP FUND
FOR NATIVE AMERICANS**

Residency: In-district only.

Area of Study: First preference to education (child development & child growth included) or business.

Academic Performance: Must have at least a cumulative 3.0 high school G.P.A. or 2.5 college G.P.A.

Enrollment Status: Full-time or part-time (minimum of six credit hours).

Financial Need: Must demonstrate financial need as shown on the Student Aid Report. First preference given to Pell grant eligible students.

Other: Must be one-quarter blood of registered tribe (copy of documentation required). Planning to transfer to a four-year institute. Must submit a recommendation from an instructor, a college counselor or a high school counselor. One page essay required answering the question, "Why is receiving this scholarship important to me?" Renewable for one semester if student maintains a minimum 2.5 G.P.A. and is enrolled and attending a minimum of six (6) credit hours. Selection of recipient will be made by the Olney Memorial Scholarship for Native Americans committee.

Amount: \$250 per semester for tuition, fees and books. One scholarship awarded per semester.

Residency: In-district resident.

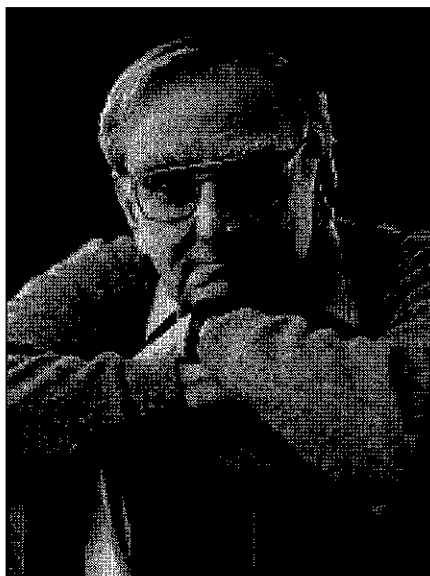
Area of Study: No requirements.

Other: Student must be planning to

Financial Need: Must demonstrate financial need. (This means the Student Aid Report indicates financial need.)

Other: Must submit a written recommendation from an instructor, a college counselor or a high school counselor. For scholarship renewal, a 2.5 G.P.A. must be maintained and at least six credit hours per semester completed. Scholarship available a maximum of four semesters, not including summer.

Other: Must be a re-entry student (out of school five years or more). Must meet above financial need and G.P.A. requirements for renewal.

Amount: Provides funds for students with special needs such as child care, excessive transportation costs, textbooks, etc.

Contact: The governing board and the re-entry coordinator make selection of recipients after interviewing candidates. Contact Re-entry Office at Longview (CC 257) for application.

Residency: No requirements.

Area of Study: No restrictions.

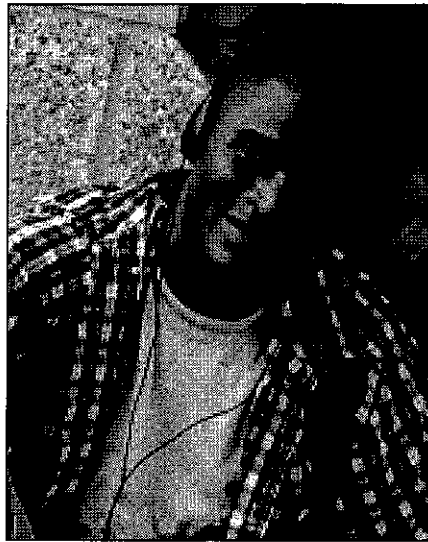
Academic Performance: Must have at least a cumulative 2.0 G.P.A.

Enrollment Status: Full-time or part-time (minimum of six credit hours).

Financial Need: Must demonstrate financial need as shown on the Student Aid Report.

Other: Must submit a written recommendation from an instructor, a college counselor or a high school counselor. Student who receives the scholarship in the fall will continue to receive funding in the spring by keeping a 2.0 (or higher) G.P.A.

Amount: One full-time award \$1,000 (to be used for in-district tuition and fees). Two part-time awards up to \$500 (to be used for in-district tuition and fees).

Amount: Based on available funds.
