- + High School Enrollment for the 2015-16 School Year will run from February 9th – February 24th
- + Current ISD students in 8th through 11th grades can enroll through PowerSchool
- + Students and/or parents log in to their PowerSchool account:
 - + powerschool.isdschools.org/public
 - + Enter your student ID number
 - + Your password is your birthdate: MMDDYY
(for example 080102)
