CLEAR YOUR WORKSPACE

 Keep food away from your workspace


• Close water bottles and set them far away.





TREAT WITH CARE

- Carry with two hands.
- Lid down. If screen is open when carrying the Chromebook, larger chance student is distracted while walking which can lead to accidents.
- Open lids carefully.
- Please do not push the lid of the computers backwards all the way.
- Plug in mice & headphones with care.
 If its does not fit, don't force to avoid pins breaking off.

CLEANING PROCEDURES

CLEANING SUPPLIES & CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

SUPPLIES: (For cleaning MONITOR, CASE & KEYBOARD)

- Microfiber cloth
- Plastic Spray bottle
- Vinegar
- Distilled Water

DIRECTIONS:

Power off the Chromebook. Fill half the plastic spray bottle with vinegar, and the other half with distilled water.

SUPPLIES (KEYBOARD & CASE CLEANING:ONLY)

Clorox wipes (excess moisture wrung out)

DIRECTIONS:

Power off the Chromebook. Ring out excess moisture from wipe. After excess moisture is removed, may use wipe to clean keyboard & case. *IMPORTANT: Using wipes on screen will damage the protective coating.*











No wipes please on monitor screen.

IMPORTANT CLEANING TIPS





Power off the computer before cleaning keyboard.



Never put a cleaning solution directly on the computer.



Abrasive material should not be used on computer screens.



Wipes (like Clorox) should not used on screens but can be used on keyboards <u>IF</u> excess moisture is wrung out first.
