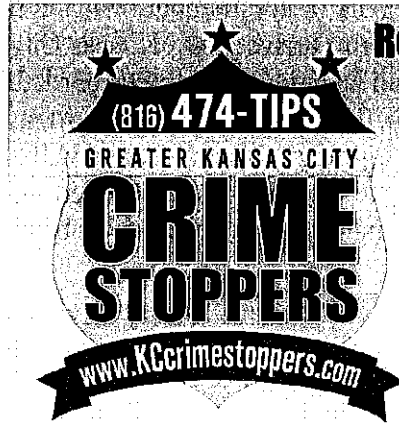

To: All Area High School Guidance Counselors

Once again this year the Crime Stoppers TIPS Hotline and the Metropolitan Police Chiefs and Sheriffs Association is sponsoring a scholarship contest for high school students. The winners, one each from the Missouri and Kansas areas of the community, will each receive a \$1,000 scholarship. The winners will be awarded a certificate and upon determination of a college or vocational school to be attended by the student, a \$1,000 check will be sent to the school in the student's name to be applied toward his/her tuition or general account.

To be eligible, the high school student must be a senior of good character with no criminal background. He/she must be recommended, in writing, by at least two faculty members. The recommendation must state the student's accomplishments, grade average, class standing, activities and the reasons he/she deserves this award. This recommendation should be no longer than two typewritten pages.

Each student entered must submit a typed essay of 750 to 1,000 words on the topic, **"TO WHAT EXTENT HAS THE ISSUE OF BULLYING, TO INCLUDE CYBER BULLYING, IMPACTED YOU PERSONALLY AND YOUR SCHOOL AS A WHOLE? WHAT CAN BE DONE TO ADDRESS THE ISSUE AND WHAT RESOURCES ARE CURRENTLY AVAILABLE TO COMBAT THE ISSUE?"**

While content and clarity of thought is of primary importance, **CONTESTANTS** should be aware that grammar and spelling **WILL BE** considered when scoring the essay. Contestants, as college bound high school seniors, are encouraged to seek out editors for their papers as


well as to proof their own work. Do not include any visual aids, graphics or other supporting documents.

This essay, along with the faculty advisors' recommendations, and the application form should be mailed in time to arrive at the Kansas City Crime Commission's office no later than Monday, November 23rd, 2015. Winners will be notified by January 8th, 2016. No telephone, written, electronic or any other means of "campaigning" for contestants will be allowed by entrants, faculty sponsors or any other person. Immediate family members of any Kansas City Crime Commission staff or board member are not eligible.
