Dear William Chrisman Students & Parent/Guardian:

The Principal's Advisory Committee worked closely with the Student Council to develop an effective plan for managing the parking lots at William Chrisman. Our policy stems primarily from safety concerns for our students and their property. All students sixteen years of age and older, with a valid driver's license (not permit) are eligible to purchase a parking pass in the amount of \$30.00* if they have provided the following information and met requirements:

All obligations must be paid in full

- Make, Model, Year and Color of Vehicle _____
- Valid driver's license # _____
- License plate # _____
- Please be prepared to show proof of insurance
- Signature accepting WCHS parking lots searches and policy ***must be signed by both*** student and guardian
- To maintain parking permit Second Semester you must meet the following conditions from Semester One:
 - 1) No more than 10 excused/unexcused absences for any class
 - 2) No more than 5 class days missed due to ISS and/or OSS

Parking violations will result in the following consequences:

- 1st offense \$30.00 ticket
- 2nd offense \$40.00 ticket
- 3rd offense \$50.00 ticket (any offenses beyond the 3rd ticket will result in parent/guardian involvement and possible loss of parking privileges)

I acknowledge and understand that:

- 1) Students are permitted to park on school premises as a matter of privilege, not of right
- 2) The School District retains authority to conduct routine patrols of student parking lot and inspections of the exteriors of student automobiles on school property
- 3) The School District may inspect the interiors of the student automobiles whenever a school authority has reasonable suspicion to believe illegal or unauthorized materials are contained inside the automobiles.
- 4) Such patrols and inspections may be conducted without notice, without student consent, and without a search warrant
- 5) If I fail to provide access to the interior of my car upon request by a school official, I will be subject to school disciplinary action.
- 6) **I have read and understand the school regulations regarding student parking at WCHS. I further agree to follow these regulations and operate my vehicle in a safe, respectful, and defensive manner. Lastly, I understand failure to comply with school regulations may result in any or all of the following; disciplinary action, loss of parking privileges, legal consequences and/or vehicle being towed.**
