What is Saturday School?

- Saturday School is an opportunity for students to work on missing assignments/take make up tests, work on homework, or complete FuelEd assignments and quizzes. There is usually at least one math teacher present from 8-10:00 or 9-11:00.
- If a student needs to make up work, a test, access computers or work on the weekend's homework, they can attend Saturday School.
- Saturday school takes place in the library and lasts from 8:00-12:00 pm. Students are not required to stay until 12:00 to come to Saturday School.

Things to remember when discussing Saturday School with student:

- Students must report at 8:00 or 10:00 A.M. sharp (doors are usually locked with no one to let you in, so if you show up late, you may have to turn around and go home) with a **student ID, homework, and a book to read. NO ID, NO ADMITTANCE, NO EXCEPTIONS!!!!**
- STUDENTS MUST SIGN UP BY 3:00 P.M. THE THURSDAY BEFORE SATURDAY SCHOOL OR THEY WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO ATTEND!!! NO EXCEPTIONS!! Sign up is online at <http://apps.isdschools.org/schoolplus/>. Students can also access the Saturday School sign up by going to the Chrisman website, clicking on "students" at the left hand side of the page under the "William Chrisman Quick Links" heading. On the "choose a school" drop down menu, select "William Chrisman" and click "filter," then log in and sign up. You can only sign up for the next Saturday School. If you cannot make it to Saturday School, you can log back in and un-enroll.
- Students planning on attending Saturday School should talk to their teachers no later than the Thursday before a Saturday School session if they need to request work from the teacher. Teachers may submit hard copies or electronic copies of work to Saturday School (including tests), however individual teachers may choose to require the student to obtain and maintain copies of their work. **TEACHERS DO NOT KNOW YOU ARE ATTENDING SATURDAY SCHOOL UNLESS YOU TELL THEM!**
- Lunch will not be provided - students should bring their own food (NO FAST FOOD) and understand that food and drinks will not be allowed around the computers.
- Saturday School behavior expectations: students should bring materials to work on, and no credit will be given for time if students are sleeping, socializing, or not working on anything; students will be given one reminder to work and then will be sent home, with an office referral sent to their house administrator); students may work cooperatively as long as they are not disturbing others; cell phones are not to be used for texting or social media; refusal to follow directions may result in losing future Saturday School privileges.
- Students will get one redirection for inappropriate behavior and then will be asked to leave if they cause any more problems.
