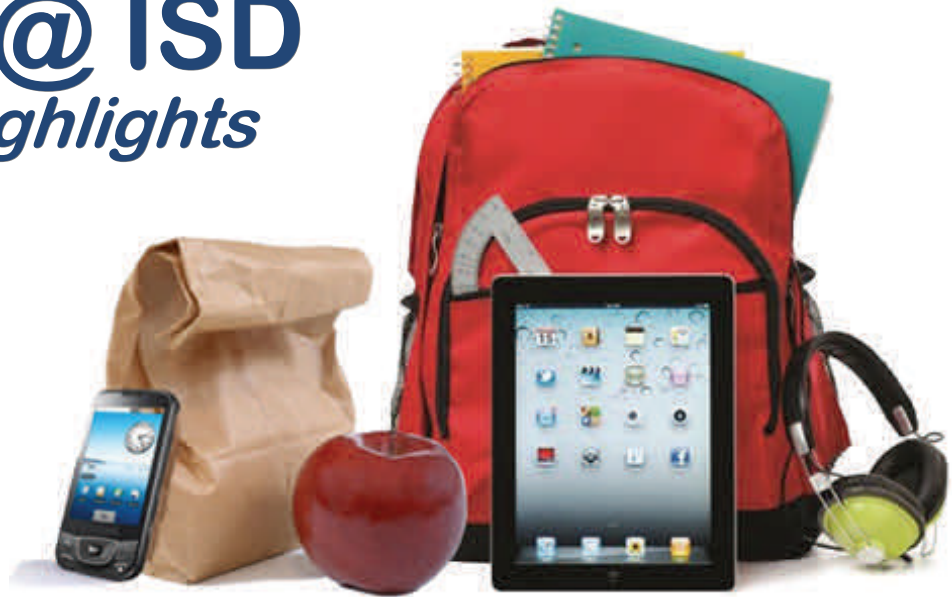


BYOT @ ISD

As new technologies continue to change the world in which we live, they also provide many new and positive educational benefits for classroom instruction. To encourage this growth, Independence School District students may bring their own technology to

campus. We want our students to be safe, legal, and responsible in their use of technology and have a strong sense of digital citizenship as part of this privilege.

Is BYOT required?

No, participation in BYOT is totally optional. The school district will provide any technology required for mandatory activities.

Is ISD liable for damage or theft?

No, it is the student's responsibility to ensure the safety and security of the device. Please set expectations with your child about proper care.

Will ISD provide technical support for student owned devices?

No, ISD does not have resources to support personally owned and configured devices. It is the student's responsibility to ensure that the device is in good working order.

When will BYOT be utilized?

Use of student devices is determined by the principal and classroom teachers on a day-to-day basis. Students will respect each teacher's rules and requests.

What can my child bring and how will they connect?

Students may bring any privately owned mobile device with WiFi capability, including:

- Laptops
- Tablets
- Smartphones
- Handhelds
- eBook Readers



ISD continues to expand wireless coverage at all campuses. Students may connect their devices to the ISD_Public_Wifi network where they will be provided content filtered Internet access in support of their learning.
